Position Title: Teacher-Physical Education (Grades K-8)

Status: Exempt

Department: Education

Reports To: School Principal

General Position Description:

Under general supervision and guidance of the Principal the incumbent provides instruction to the students of the United Auburn Indian Community School (Grades K-8) in the knowledge and skills of physical education. Performance will be evaluated by the Principal through direct observation and to established policies and achievement of performance standards. The incumbent will instruct students in grades K through 8 in the knowledge and skills of physical education. Duties include selection of a curriculum, development of a scope and sequence of instruction, and the creation of a flexible program and environment favorable to learning and personal growth in accordance with each student's ability. In addition, the incumbent will assist in other school programs as assigned.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Plans a balanced physical education program
- Develops lesson plans and age appropriate instruction
- adapting daily schedules to accommodate weather conditions
- Analyzes, demonstrates and explains basic skills, knowledge and strategies in formal sports, games, rhythm and fundamentals of body movement
- Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt curriculum to the needs of the students
- Holds a valid CPR certificate through UAIC
- Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt curriculum to the needs of the students with varying abilities, and to accommodate a variety of instructional activities
- Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior required to provide an orderly and productive environment

- Participates cooperatively with the appropriate administrators to develop the method by which he/she will be evaluated
- Communicates with parents and the education team on student progress
- Cooperates in school-wide supervision of students during out-of-classroom activities
- Participates in faculty and/or UAIC committees and the sponsorship of student activities
- Meets professional obligations with respect to punctuality, attendance and routine duties
- Performs other duties as assigned

KASOC's-Knowledge, Abilities, Skills, & Other Competencies

- Knowledge of educational principles of physical education instruction
- Ability to plan effective instruction and use multiple teaching strategies
- Ability to assess student learning, monitor student understanding and adjust instruction appropriately
- Skill in using technologies to increase student learning and confidence to learn
- Ability to work under pressure, to pay attention to detail, to concentrate and to follow directions
- Ability to maintain appropriate confidentiality in all matters pertaining to students, parents, staff and program
- Knowledge and skill to plan and prepare courses and lessons which reflect the schools' academic standards, are appropriate to the needs, experience and existing knowledge of the students' individual and/or classroom instruction at all grade levels.

Minimum Qualifications

Educational:

- Bachelor's Degree with major or minor in physical education or equivalent.

- Possession of a valid California credential authorizing service as a physical education teacher.

Preferred or Desirable Qualifications

- Direct experience working with diverse children and adults, or a background in the philosophy regarding the education of diverse children and adults; knowledge of learning disabilities.
- Knowledge of best practices in teaching Native American students, course work (or willingness to take course work) in Native American studies, teaching to different learning styles, differentiated and multi-modality instruction.

- Outdoor and Classroom/Office Environment

Physical Demands

- Hearing and speaking to exchange information
- Seeing to monitor students
- Dexterity of hands and fingers to demonstrate activities or games
- Standing for extended periods of time
- Walking, running and jumping
- Lifting, carrying, pushing or pulling light to moderately heavy objects
- Bending at the waist, kneeling or crouching to assist students
